



**Call for expression of interest for recruitment of
A Chief Legal Counsel**

The Hellenic Financial Stability Fund ("Fund"), is a Legal Entity of Private Law, established by Law 3864/2010. The Fund is headquartered in Athens and its duration is set to June 30th 2020, with the possibility of renewal following a decision by the Minister of Finance. The Fund intends to recruit a **Chief Legal Counsel**. The executive will be selected on the basis of an assessment of qualifications and will be recruited under lawyers' contract (συμβάση έμμισθης εντολής). The remuneration will be determined according to candidate's qualifications and experience and according to the Funds internal policies. The staff of the Fund has a duty of loyalty to the Fund and a duty of strict confidentiality according to the provisions of Law 3864/2010, as in force. .

The position reports to the Executive Board and General Council.

Skills and qualifications

- Bachelor's degree in Law and Master's Degree in Banking Law, Commercial law Competition Law or Corporate Law.
- Knowledge of the European Union legislation and organization; knowledge of state aid legislation.
- At least 16 years of previous experience as a Legal Counsellor with proven previous experience on handling relevant legal related issues including at least 4 years as Chief Legal Counsel or Head of Legal Team.
- Excellent knowledge on English and law terminology.
- Ability to work under pressure, team worker, adaptability to change, ability to influence based on valid argumentation.
- Outstanding communication and negotiation abilities.
- Integrity and confidentiality.

Assignment (key tasks and responsibilities)

- Provide legal counseling to the governing bodies of the Fund for any legal issue related to the Fund's operations and objectives.
- Implementation of the legal framework for the day-to-day operation of the HFSF (advisory support in legal matters related to HFSF's operations, drafting of all types of contracts (employment contracts, contracts with the external advisors and service providers), communication with the supervisory authorities, (drafting and review of all type of official letters and completion of all legal formalities).
- Drafts legal and regulatory provisions, .
- Drafts and reviews legal issues that: (i) arise as a result of capital injections to credit institutions and/or transitional credit institutions according to the Law, (ii) are related to supported credit institution's transactions, (iii) are associated to supported credit institution's share capital increases.
- Communicates with legal departments of all the relevant European Bodies for the cases of the Fund.
- Handles and provides consultation for the legal cases managed by the fund.
- Drafts and/or reviews internal documents, such as internal policies and regulations.
- Address every legal issue arising from the relationship framework agreements between the HFSF and the credit institutions and address every legal issue arising from the above.
- Represents the Fund towards any Court.
