Role & Responsibilities

- Assists the Head of Strategy in the designing and execution of the HFSF's strategy in relation to its holdings (portfolio banks)
- Assist to the HFSF strategic priorities in relation to its shareholding role and proposes value enhancement initiatives for portfolio banks through analysis, while cooperating with the key stakeholders within the unit and other units
- Monitors closely banks' performance and assesses business plans, in order to provide meaningful insights and input to the Unit

Candidate Qualifications:

- Minimum six (6) years for the Strategy Officer and nine (9) for the Senior Officer of previous experience from a strategic planning/ strategy department of a financial institution and/or a strategy consulting firm
- Previous experience on planning, exploring, analyzing and evaluating business plans for financial institutions, including 3YR business plans, budgets, bank re-organizations/ transformations
- Previous expertise in the areas of M&A, valuation, financial due diligence, transaction support, financial modelling will be considered an asset
- Experience from exposure to senior Management and decision-making by key senior stakeholders
- Analytical and strategic thinking, ability to develop and if necessary, produce complex analysis to support decision making
- Knowledge of the Greek and European Banking sector's strategic challenges is a must
- Advanced communication and presentation skills, ability to produce insightful and sophisticated reports and communicate complex information clearly and concisely within time constraints is necessary
